Presenters:

Jerry Krause: Coach Krause is currently the Director of Men's Basketball Operations for Gonzaga University. He has authored more than 30 books on coaching basketball, produced 31 instructional videos, six DVD's, two CD's and serves as a consultant to many athletic organizations. He is the most widely published coach in basketball history, surpassing the legendary Clair Bee. He had a 17-year career as head coach at Eastern Washington University. During that span, Eagle teams posted a 262-196 record for a .572 winning percentage. He took a sabbatical from EWU to assist the late Ralph Miller at Oregon State University from 1982-83, then returned to EWU to lead the Eagles from the NAIA and into the NCAA Division I ranks. He was inducted into the EWU Athletic Hall of Fame on Oct. 1, 2005. He has served on the NCAA Rules Committee, was on the Board of Directors of the National Association of Basketball Coaches and served on the Selection Committee of the National Basketball Hall of Fame. He still serves as Research Chair of the NABC. He is also a member of the NAIA Basketball Coaches and National Association for Sports and Physical Education Halls of Fame.

Barry Adams: Regarded as one of the top high school coaches in Oregon's history, Barry coached for over 40 years amassing 656 career wins while coaching many outstanding post players. He has coached 7 NCAA D-1 posts and operated the Cascade Sports Camp for 39 years. Coach Adams' teams have always been known for their efficient and productive post play.

Brad Barbarick- Coach Barbarick began his stint at Concordia University for the 1993-94 season. Coach Barbarick took the Cavaliers to the Cascade Conference Championship in 1999-00 season, where they made their first trip to the NAIA National Tournament, finishing in the "Sweet 16." Coach Barbarick was also named Conference Coach of the year for the 2002-03 season. Brad was coached by fellow member Shim Shimizu at the John Wooden UCLA Basketball camps in the 1970's. Coach Shim later became his assistant at Concordia University. Brad and his wife, Dana have three children; twins Emily and Megan and son, Zachary. Coach Barbarick served on the Win the Tip! Board of Directors from 2004-06.

Keith Cooper- The Head Men's Basketball Coach at Saint Martin's College, a NCAA Division II school in Lacey, WA. Coach Cooper began his position with the Saints in the spring of 2003. Coach Cooper has over 17 years of coaching experience and was named 'All Area' Coach of the year in 1999, when he led Decatur High School (WA) to the West Central District Championship. He has a social studies education degree from Seattle Pacific and a Masters degree in Athletic Administration from Pacific Lutheran. Keith and his wife, Linda have one son, Keith Owen.

Todd Kent- Coach Kent is currently the Head Girl's Basketball Coach at La Salle High School in Yakima, WA. In five seasons he has compiled a record of 100-23. His teams have won four League Titles, three District Titles, Two Regional Titles, and the State B Championship in 2006. Coach Kent is the Dean of Students and AP History Teacher at La Salle. He enjoys hiking the Cascades with his wife Stephanie, who is a Public Health Nurse. They have two dogs, Hobbs and Daisy.

Pete Van Mullem- Co-Founder of Win the Tip! and Assistant Men's Basketball Coach at Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, ID, Coach Van Mullem is beginning his fifth year as the Executive Director of Win the Tip! Coach Van Mullem began his coaching career in High School where he spent six seasons as an assistant basketball coach, before moving to the collegiate ranks where he has spent the past 6 years at the NCAA Division I, NCAA Division II, and NAIA levels. He is currently pursuing his Ph.D. in Sport Ethics from the University of Idaho.
